Parcel abuts Cove Road, an ancient way (shown on 1858 County Atlas) running from Freemans Way south to Cahoons Pond



Parcel includes 600 feet of frontage on Freemans Way, a major arterial



A network of hiking trails criss-cross the parcel, portions lush with a checkerberry groundcover



Parcel abuts Nickerson State Park (note blue tree marker for NSP boundary)



This meadow signifies the historic homestead of the William Maker family who lived off Cove Road in the early 1800s.



A mature 60-foot high American holly, unusual for this end of Cape Cod, grows at the southern edge of the parcel.
