

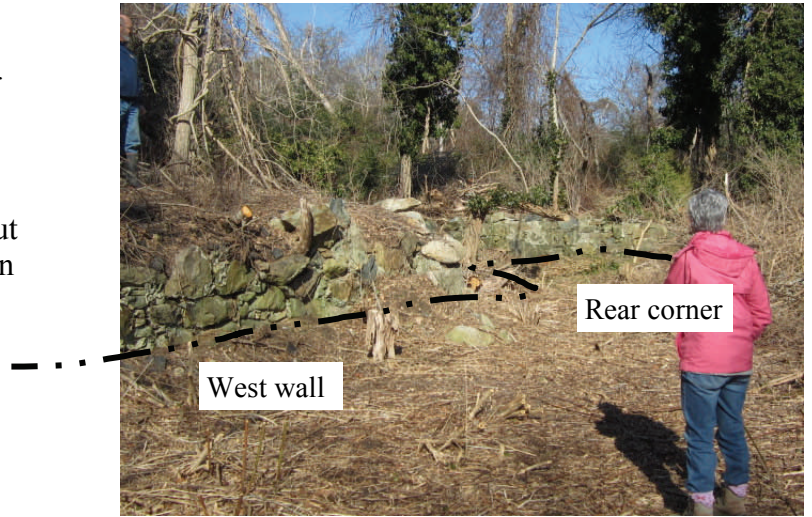
Remaining foundation walls and well of house of John J. Hassard, Lower Road, Brewster MA, on 32-acre property owned by the Brewster Conservation Trust

Entire length is about 75 feet including rear corner (30 ft long) and west wall (45 ft long). Was rear corner the barn and west wall the house?

The house was lived in by the Hassards from about 1870 to 1899. What happened to it after that, when the Thorndike/Eddy family bought it, remains a mystery.

(Paul Gasek says the wall-building skill matches dry walls he has seen in Ireland and Scotland.)
