

## **Brewster Walking Trails**



## 10 Freemans South Aquifer Protection Area

This area is a collection of lands purchased over time to protect the town's water supply. Originally planned for development, the properties contain cart paths and crisscrossing foot trails. The red trail winds through a hilly pitch pine and oak forest. There is a huckleberry understory and a scattering of beech trees. The blue trail cuts through an even-aged pine barren. Much of the blue trail follows what had been cleared for a road, providing for a flat and level walk. An overlook of Cahoon Pond is located at the southern most portion of the trail.



**Red trail round trip:** 1.75 miles **Blue trail round trip:** 1.50 miles

**Directions:** Park in the lot on the north side of Route 137, or along the south side of Freemans Way.
