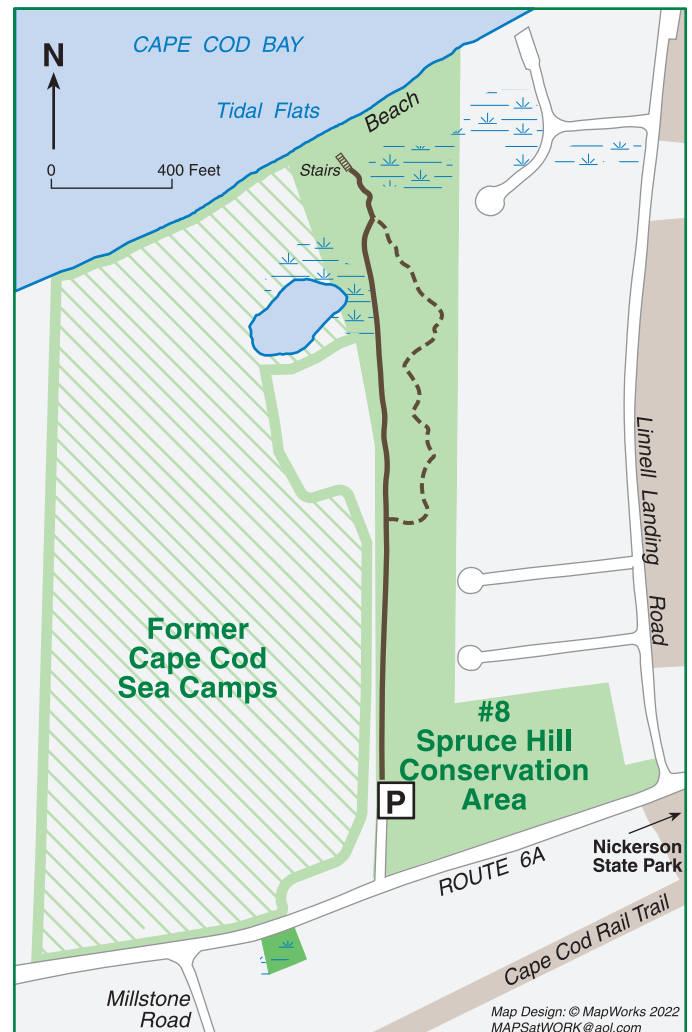

# Brewster Walking Trails



## 8 Spruce Hill Conservation Area

The Spruce Hill Conservation Area runs north from Route 6A to Cape Cod Bay. It is named after the grove of tall Norway Spruce trees. From the parking lot, a wide path runs beneath a canopy of oak and pine. Before the path crosses the dune to Cape Cod Bay, there is a low area with swamp azalea, viburnum, and a stand of black gum.

In 2021 the Town of Brewster purchased the adjacent 55-acre former Cape Cod Sea Camps property. Future public access and use is being planned.

**Trail round trip: 0.8 miles**

**Directions:** The parking area is located off Route 6A, 0.3 miles to the east of the former Cape Cod Sea Camps entrance.
